Dear Sagebrush Families,

We have had a wonderful start to the 2018/2019 school year. As I've walked the building, visited classrooms and conducted Principal Chats, I have noticed that teachers and students alike are excited about the opportunities for a new year. We are lucky to be a part of such a supportive community focused on maintaining what is best for all of our students.

Please be aware that safety is an important focus for us here at school. To that end, we ask that you always check in at the office with a picture ID so we can provide you with a visitor sticker. When dropping students off in the mornings, please say your goodbyes at the outside doors and not enter the building. If you are volunteering, please drop your student off as normal, then come through the front doors to acquire a visitor sticker. We are also asking that students not play on the playground in the mornings before school. Even though some children are supervised by their parents, others are not and it creates a safety concern since we do not have staff supervising the playground.

Our school-wide expectations are focused around the acronym P.A.W.S.

P – Pride: Taking pride in ourselves, our classroom and our school.

A – Attitude: Maintaining a good attitude about school.

W – Working Hard: Doing our best to learn as much as we can, each and every day.

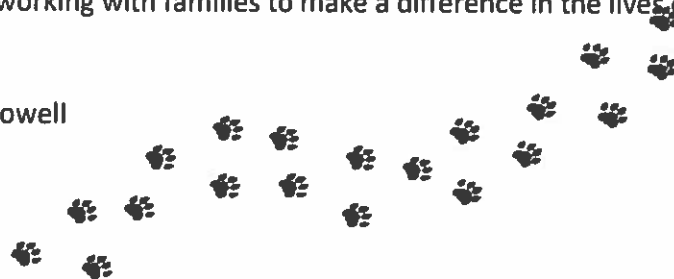
S – Safety: Following the directions of adults and school rules to maintain the physical and emotional safety of all.

From the Nurse's Desk



Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back to an exciting new school year. I am Chana Aminov and I am the full time nurse at Sagebrush Elementary. I hope everyone had a great and relaxing summer break. One of my focuses is to keep the students in school safe and healthy and with your help we can accomplish this and have a fantastic year at Sagebrush.

Just as a reminder of a few rules in the clinic. All medications, that are not Over The Counter (OTC), that need to be given at school need doctor orders signed by the physician, whether the medication is for daily use or on an as needed basis. The medication needs to be brought to school by the parent in the original box and with the original pharmacy label on it. If OTC medications are needed such as; Tylenol, Motrin, cough drops etc. we do have some in the clinic, however, you must have parent permission signed in PowerSchool. If a student needs OTC medications for more than a few days we ask you to please provide a bottle of what they need as we have a limited supply. If an OTC medication is needed on a regular basis to treat a condition again orders are needed and signed by the physician.

Another reminder for students with life threatening allergies or asthma that requires an inhaler, please bring the emergency medication, epi pen, Benadryl, inhaler, with signed care plans/consent forms to the clinic ASAP. The forms need to be signed by the physician. If medication and consent are not on hand and your child has an allergic reaction/asthma episode an ambulance will be called.

No student can carry any medication on them at any time! This is for the safety of your child and the other children in the classroom.

IMMUNIZATIONS: Everyone needs to have the following immunizations and required doses: Hepatitis B- 3 doses, DTAP- 5 doses, Polio- 4 doses, MMR-2 doses, Varicella-2 doses. It is now required to have these vaccines prior to entering Kindergarten. If your child is not up to date, please bring them to the doctor to receive the required doses. If they are not compliant you will receive a letter with an exclusion date if those vaccines are not up to date.

IMMUNIZATION EXEMPTION CHANGES: Students with Medical exemptions need to only bring exemption papers one time to the school. Students with Personal or Religious exemptions must bring forms for exemption every single year. If you have not done so yet, your child is not compliant. Please go to this site to fill out an exemption form. <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/vaccine-exemptions>. You have an option of filling it out online and printing it or registering in the information. Or to print the form and fill it out. Whatever route you chose please send a copy to school with your child to bring to me. Or you can write the student's name, date of birth, and your address and list which shots you are seeking exemption for and sign at the bottom.

We ask that you please have current and working phone numbers in PowerSchool in the event that we need to reach you.

If your child has any health concerns that need my attention please give me a call so we can discuss it or stop by the clinic.

Even though we have yet to hit the winter months, we are seeing many illnesses go around already. If you are not sure whether to send your child to school you can always give me a call. Some of the main reasons to keep children at home are if they are too ill to participate in normal activities, they require more care than teachers and staff can give while caring for other children, or they have an illness that requires exclusion from school. Just as a reminder children with a fever over 100 with any symptoms, vomiting or diarrhea must be kept at home for 24 hours after last episode. For other illness if you are not sure whether they can come to school or not please give me a call and I can help guide your decision.

I am very happy to be here and please don't hesitate to call me for questions.
