From the Nurse:

It is amazing how fast the school year has flown by. I took great pleasure in working with your children this school year. I am happy to be here to make sure your children stay healthy and safe in school.

Medications:

As the school year comes to an end all medications in the clinic have to be picked up. **Please make arrangements to pick up your student's medication from the school health office on or before the last day of school. We cannot send medications home with students. The last day of school is Friday May 25, 2018. Kids dismiss at 11 am. ALL medication such as prescription, over-the-counter, Epi-Pens and Inhalers, must be picked up by a parent/guardian by the last day of school or it will be disposed of by the end of that day. We cannot keep any medications in the clinic over the summer.**

If your child will be in the before and after care program this summer please let me know. I can hand over to the director the medication, but I have to be made aware by you to do so.

For all those who have any sort of medication in the clinic, we will send home a letter along with medication orders for next year. If you know your student needs a medication for next year please give us a call and we can send the order home with them. **We require a new Physician order for every school year.** Please complete the forms over the summer for a smooth transition into the next school year.

Immunizations:

For the 5th grade students that are entering 6th grade, the TDAP immunization (1 shot) is required for 6th grade entry. While most students need this shot, some already have the vaccine. If you have any question regarding what shots your child has feel free to call me and ask.

Kindergarten entry requirement: **Hepatitis B- 3 doses, DTAP- 5 doses, Polio- 4 doses, MMR-2 doses, Varicella-2 doses.** If your child is not up to date in Kindergarten or a different grade please bring them to the doctor to receive the required doses. If they are not compliant you will receive a letter with an exclusion date if those vaccines are not up to date. Please bring me any new shot records from over the summer.

Students with Personal or Religious exemptions have to bring forms for exemption every single year. If you have not done so yet, your child is not compliant. Please go to this site to fill out an exemption form. <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/vaccine-exemptions>. You have an option of filling it out online and printing it or to print the form and fill it out. Whatever route you chose please send a copy to school with your child to bring to me. If I am not made aware that the form was filled by you I have no way of knowing.

Sun Safety:

The weather is getting warmer and sunnier as the school days come to a near. It is always a good idea to send kids to school with a water bottle that they can re-fill throughout the day to prevent dehydration. Sun screen safety is always important as well as kids are outside during sunny times. Per the American Academy of Dermatology, it is recommended to choose a sunscreen that has an SPF of 30 or higher, is water resistant, and provides broad-spectrum coverage.

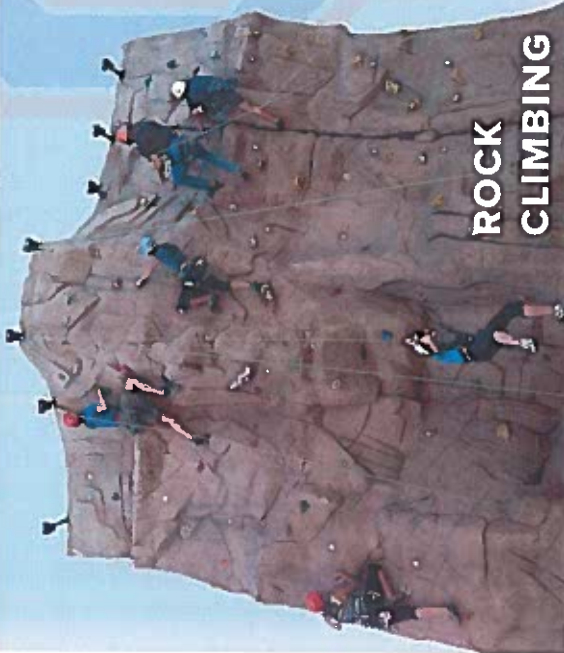
The **Creek Adventure Program** is proud to announce that the **2018 CHALLENGE COURSE** and **ROCK CLIMBING** summer camps are open for registration!
