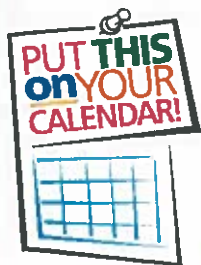

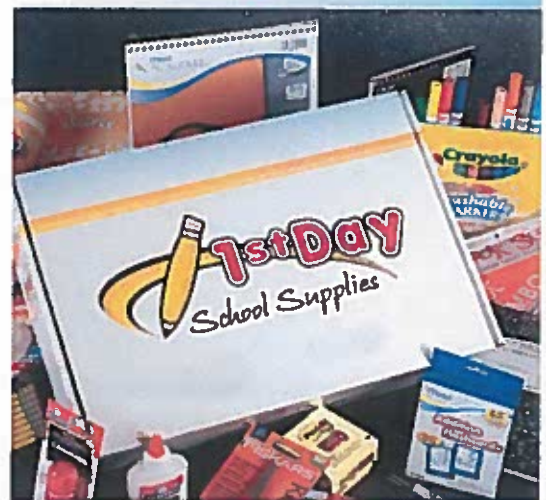

A Note from the Nurse's Clinic

The end of the school year is quickly approaching!

Your student has one or more medications in the school clinic. Please plan to pick up these medications no later than the last day of school for students.

Colorado Board of Health guidelines prohibit schools from storing medication over the summer when school is not in session. **All medications not claimed by the last day of school for students will be disposed of per Colorado Board of Health guidelines.**

Elementary students: If your student will be attending the extended childcare program this summer at his or her home school, we can transfer their unexpired medications to the care of the ECS Director for summer needs. (Please call the school nurse if this applies to you).

We know you want to plan ahead. The medication forms for next school year are available on the Cherry Creek School District website, under the Health Services Department.

Dear Third and Fourth Grade Parents,

Our school will be offering the Battle of Books Club again next school year for all 4th and 5th grade students who are interested in participating. The *Battle of the Books Literacy Club* is designed to encourage elementary students to:

- Read quality literature.
- Read over the summer months and in their leisure time during the school year.
- Read for information as well as pleasure.

By choosing to participate in this club, your child will be introduced to a variety of fiction and non-fiction books. Many of the books are award-winning pieces of literature. Students of all reading levels are invited to participate. Students who participate in this club must agree to read at least seven titles from the booklist by the end of January. Summer is a great time to get started. In February, we will have a school-wide battle with questions from all of the books. Our winning team will represent Sagebrush at a district semi-final Battle of the Books competition next spring.

You do not have to decide now whether or not to have your child participate. A permission slip will come home in the fall with dates of when we start meeting regularly. We plan on having several sessions devoted to just relaxing and reading, in addition to sessions devoted to practice battles/preparation for answering questions about the books. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the booklist so that your child may begin reading some of the books over the summer.
